Saint Anthony of Padua will visit our Church on November 7th. Fr. Alex Ratti, a friar from the Basilica in Padua will accompany two first-class relics of the beloved Saint Anthony of Padua to NS. One reliquary contains layers of skin of Saint Anthony's cheek and the 2nd reliquary contains a fragment of the Saint's Floating Ribs. The Floating Rib relic has special meaning because it was received in the Cathedral of Buenos Aires by the then-Archbishop of Jorge Maria Bergoglio (now Pope Francis) in the year 2000. This same relic was also venerated by Sister Lucia of Fatima in her convent in Coimbra, Portugal, in 1995, for the 800th anniversary of Saint Anthony's birth. Veneration starts at 9:30am with Mass at noon and Veneration afterward until 1:30pm. Intention Envelopes will be available soon to use to send your intentions to St. Anthony's Tomb in Padua Italy.
